region, combines elements of PYP and IPC, encouraging students to critically explore different subjects and integrate their knowledge to develop problem-solving skills.

Secondary school aims to prepare students for further education overseas, with senior students studying IGCSE and A-Level qualifications, enabling them to apply to top universities in the UK, USA, Australia, and Canada. The holistic approach to teaching also encompasses physical education, music, art, extracurricular activities, and the Duke of Edinburgh Award, developing each student's leadership, social skills, and personal interests.

Our Forest School education is tailored to children aged between 3 and 6 years old. Despite inclement weather conditions, barring extreme weather or heavy pollution, our teachers guide the children to engage with nature. By learning in

this manner, children's sensory perception becomes heightened in response to natural stimuli, including sight, hearing, smell, taste, and touch.



PRIMARY SCHOOL

At Malvern College Chengdu, our primary education curriculum is designed to offer a unique blend of Chinese national curriculum and international education teaching and assessment methods.

Our dedicated academic team has developed a rigorous curriculum that seamlessly integrates East and West, emphasising academic excellence and a well-rounded education.

Under our "Exploring the World" framework, we use interdisciplinary teaching methodologies that foster collaboration

SECONDARY SCHOOL

In lower secondary (Grades 7 to 9), we provide an integrated and bilingual curriculum that combines the best practices of Chinese and international pedagogy, including inquiry-based and

student-centered learning. Our holistic approach, centered on the Malvern Qualities and Malvern DNA, emphasizes the development of the whole child, and includes specialized courses in areas such as Entrepreneurship and Global Perspectives.

Our Secondary International Centre is designed for senior high school students pursuing post-compulsory education (Grades 10-13). The center offers a comprehensive range of Cambridge and Edexcel IGCSE and IAL (International A-level) courses, which are widely recognized and respected globally. Upon graduation, our students have access to the most prestigious universities in the UK, USA, China Hong Kong, Australia, Canada, mainland Europe, and beyond.
